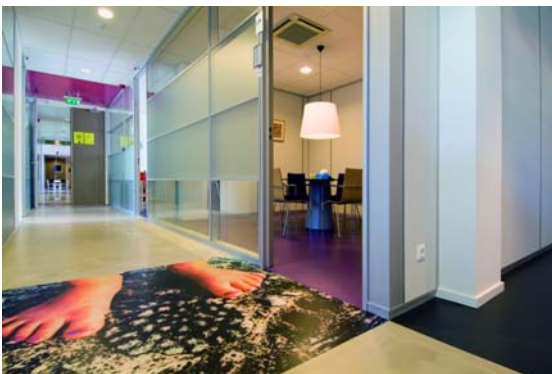


A big step forward

The Youth Welfare Bureau classifies its clients into several age groups. In the interior, this distinction is marked by colours and photographs that were used in the floors and on the walls.
